Title of Position: Traveling Barista

Summary: As a Traveling Barista at The Funky Brewster, your job will be to work independently or as part of a team to transport, assemble/disassemble, and operate our mobile coffee carts at various events throughout your region, while living out our mission: The Funky Brewster exists to use the simplicity of coffee to create an experience that inspires connection across the table and around the world.

Company Culture: We believe in the creativity of coffee and the value of relationships. The simplicity of a cup of coffee creates an experience that inspires connection; from the fellow barista or client sitting "across the table", to the farmers who handpick each coffee cherry "around the world". We celebrate and honor the connections that are made by respecting each other, serving our clients with extraordinary hospitality, and remembering the origin of each bean.

Key Responsibilities:

- Complete The Funky Brewster training program and become a Certified Barista.
- Execute all scheduled events within the specified timeframe.
- Transport equipment, products and supplies in either your own vehicle or one provided by the company, while maintaining a clean driving record and valid auto insurance.
- Provide extraordinary hospitality to our clients and their guests by:
 - Consistently communicating with your host throughout the service: relaying start and stop times, collecting payment, and addressing any other needs during the event.
 - Showing professionalism through your words, actions, timeliness and physical appearance.
 - Answering questions, anticipating needs, and educating guests about our menu, products, and company, while handcrafting exceptional beverages.
 - Operating with efficiency and confidence while at your event, ensuring everyone experiences legendary service, and minor issues are swiftly handled without incident.
 - Maintaining a clean, organized workspace and leaving areas better than you found them.
 - Locating the event address, unloading and parking by effectively using a combination of the information provided, navigation and deductive reasoning.
- Respect your team by:
 - Ensuring each cart you return is clean, well-maintained, restocked and ready for the next event.
 - Utilizing the tools and resources available to independently and proactively solve problems, stay well-informed, answer questions that come your way, and pursue ongoing development.
 - Embodying a culture of honor by addressing issues or concerns one-on-one with the appropriate person, rather than talking to someone who has no power to change the situation.
 - Acknowledging that you are part of a team and understanding the importance of your role in creating a healthy and enjoyable work environment by exemplifying integrity, being mentally and physically present, and being on time.
 - Promoting ongoing, open communication with your manager and team to ensure your own success and the success of the company.

Time Commitment: The Traveling Barista position is part-time. You are expected to establish and maintain a consistent availability, with the understanding that our schedule fluctuates week to week, and you may not always be scheduled for your full availability. You may be asked to work beyond your availability during periods of high volume. You are expected to attend all scheduled shifts, meetings, trainings and paid Barista events.
